



Congratulations, your vehicle just had Paint Protection Film applied!

With a few simple instructions, we can assure the longevity, performance and clarity of the film. If you have any questions, please contact us before touching the film or trying to remedy something yourself. We can only support what we install.

- It is safe to drive in the rain.
- Do not wash the vehicle for 48 hours from this date, even by hand.
- Wait a full week to wax the surfaces where the film is applied, do NOT use oil based or carnauba wax or cleaners, only synthetic or polymer products. Oil based products will yellow the film, which is not warranty!
- The film has a clear-coat layer so it does not require any waxing, but it can be waxed with the paint. It requires no special care; avoid compounds, as they tend to be abrasive, avoid chemicals, which may harm plastic – it is not indestructible.
- For the first 30 days, the film may be hazy or milky to look at and small water bubbles can be present. This will all dry through the film and all moisture and cloudiness will be gone.
- Do not lift or peel any edges. The film cannot be re-applied.
- In many areas where the film stops there will be a small line at the edge of the film. This is normal; it is not intended to be invisible. If this line accumulates wax build up, simply clean with a moist cotton ball. If more cleaning power is required add a sparing amount of isopropyl alcohol (70% or less) to the cotton ball and wipe with the line not against it. Some films are “self-healing” and small scratches will absorb overnight.

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
